2010 WYOPASS AWARDS



CATEGORIES AND CRITERIA

Planning Project – Urban: In recognition of an outstanding planning project in a large population base, that promotes solid principles and practices that lead to results.

- **Criteria** – Urban awards shall be for designated first class cities or populations over 4,000 and counties with population over 25,000. The nominated Plan must be completed and implemented or include an implementation schedule along with documentation of financial commitment, citizen involvement and community support for the project. *Nominee must be a full member of WYOPASS.*

Planning Project – Rural: In recognition of an outstanding planning project in a small population base which promotes solid principles and practices that lead to results.

- **Criteria** – Rural awards are designated for smaller communities with population under 4,000 or counties with population under 25,000. The nominated plan must be completed and implemented. The project must show citizen involvement and community support. *Nominee must be a full member of WYOPASS.*

Planner of the Year: In recognition of significant contributions pertaining to planning in Wyoming.

- **Criteria** – Nominee may be a consultant or government planning practitioner. Nominee will be judged on examples of work related projects, activities, achievements, community involvement, accomplishments, and demonstrated commitment to the planning profession.

Planner of the Year – New Professional: In recognition of outstanding work by a planner who is new to the profession.

- **Criteria** – Nominee should be someone who has recently entered the planning profession. Nominee will be judged on attitude, ability to work with the public and staff, recent accomplishments and any other asset of this person.

Planning and Zoning Commissions – Group or Individual: In recognition of dedicated service on behalf of planning in Wyoming's communities and counties.

- **Criteria** - Appointed Commission - town, city, or county citizens or individual appointed to a local government planning body such as the planning and zoning commission or board of adjustment; meets on a regular basis; proven commitment to sound planning principles; support for local planning efforts
